

Wrinkle Reduction with Bo-tox

Wrinkles always come too early!

What is Bo-tox?

Bo-tox is a highly refined, purified, diluted substance which is most effective in improving lines due to facial expressions; for example worry lines or frown lines. These lines are usually caused by overactive muscles

and the treatment helps these muscles relax, thus reducing the lines and wrinkles.

What is Hyperhidrosis?

Hyperhidrosis is the medical term for sweating in excess of physiological needs. There is no standard definition of excess sweating. However, it is described as any degree of sweating that interferes with normal activities of daily living.

Can Bo-tox treatment help?

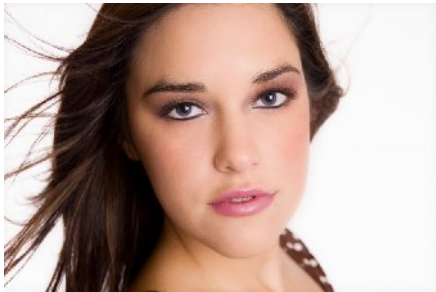
Bo-tox is administered by injecting it into the specific problem area where it alleviates the mechanism of sweating. A topical anaesthetic cream is applied to the area in order to make the procedure easier and reduce any minimal discomfort.

How long does the treatment take?

In most cases a session will take between 10 and 20 minutes. T

he effects of the treatment will begin to appear very quickly within 48 to 72 hours although the full extent of the treatment may not be visible for up to 10 days. Approximately two weeks after the first treatment, the effects will be reviewed with your practitioner and any further treatments or top-ups can be discussed.



Is the treatment uncomfortable?

Very tiny needles are used to inject the solution and only small amounts are used. As a result any discomfort is usually minimal and short-lived. There is no need for any sedation or anaesthesia.

Are there any adverse effects?

This treatment has been used in thousands of patients over the last fifteen years. It has an excellent safety profile and there have been no serious side-effects reported in association with its use.

In a small number of cases there may be some localised bruising, slight swelling or redness at the site of the injection. This usually disappears

very quickly and can respond to the application of a cool pack to the area.

As soon as your treatment is over you can resume normal daily activities.

Do the effects of this treatment look artificial?

No, unlike some surgical facelifts, this kind of treatment is very specific and works on only those muscles that are involved in producing the facial lines that you want to reduce. The other muscles are unaffected and this means that your usual facial expressions will be the same.

How long will the effects of this treatment last?

Initially the improvement that you will receive from this treatment will last from 3 to 6 months. You will notice a gradual fading effect and at this stage you can return for another treatment if you want to. With repeated treatments, the effect lasts longer.
